His Royal Highness, Prince Salman bin Abdulaziz was born in Riyadh on December 31, 1935. He was educated at the Princes' School in Riyadh where he studied sciences, religion, and the Holy Qur'an. Prince Salman was appointed Crown Prince of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and Deputy Prime Minister by the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz, on June 18, 2012. He also serves as the Minister of Defense of the Kingdom. King Abdulaziz appointed Prince Salman as the Emir of Riyadh in March 1954, when he was just 19 years old. He served as Deputy Governor of Riyadh for just over a year. Then, he became Governor of Riyadh until 1960 and again from 1963 to 2011, when he became the Minister of Defense. He was also Honorary President of the Friends of the Red Crescent and President of the Higher Committee for the Development of Riyadh. The Prince helped Riyadh develop from a mid-sized town into a major urban metropolis. He attracted a lot of tourism, business, and investment in the Kingdom. Today, Riyadh is one of the richest cities in the world, and it is a major center of travel and trade.
